Market very useful for fresh fruit and vegetables and baked goods. Monoprix supermarket is near end of market. If you don't want to cook much there is Picard frozen food store with a very wide variety of instant meals. If you need hardware and electrical stuff and more there is a small store on rue Legendre.

I really enjoyed my stay and the “real” family neighbourhood and its diversity. I did wish I had brought light layers of clothing as it was warmer than I anticipated! The “comfortable” shoe store at the corner of Legendre and Levis saved me as my feet were suffering.

I have been coming to Paris regularly since 1967 so for us it's returning to our favourite sites and haunts rather than "sightseeing". I have watched Paris change in 40 years and to me Levis seems "real" and the way Paris used to be. If you get tired of the noise and hustle of Levis – turn right out of the front door and walk down 2 blocks. A different quartier quiet- nice shops and we thought better quality and more friendly. Be sure to visit La Cité de l'Architecture et du Patrimoine at the Palais de Chaillot (metro Trocadero). It just opened this week and is a magnificent display of cathedral portals, sculpture, and stained glass. Also, Musée Marmatton in the 16th and the Musée Nationale of the Middle Ages (Cluny) at rue St. Germain and rue St. Michel. Everyone rushes to the Louvre – these museums are quieter and are gems. Favorite restaurants: Preuve par Neuf on rue Damrémont for dinner – reasonably priced good food. For lunch, La Loire dans la Theiere at the corner of rue des Rosiers and rue Mahler in the 4th. This is the Marais area so don't miss the Place des Vosges. Also near the Jewish quarter – great falafel on rue des Rosiers. Take the bus whenever you can (#31 goes to Trocadero) you see more. We hope you come to love France as much as we do. This is a perfect place to begin – on the rue de Levis!

P.S. The Museum of the History of Montmartre is fascinating and the back side of the hill with its narrow streets, vineyards and views is a wonderful walk.
